- Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. Please limit the number of guests you have in attendance. The guest fee is required of each guest whether it is swimming and/or use of the tennis courts. You are responsible for the actions of your guests. (A member is someone who is part of your immediate household.)
- All children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by a person 18 years of age or older who can swim. Children who are at least 14, able to swim well, and have a buddy of the same age or older with them may swim without an adult present.
- Only one person is allowed on the slide or diving board at a time. Use the slide as it is intended. Any abuses will be dealt with accordingly. Please help keep these two facilities safe so that they may be enjoyed in the years to come. If you are the last one to leave the pool area, please turn the water off to the slide.
- Do not prop the gate open! This is for liability reasons. If you happen to notice the gate open, please stop and close it.
- Clean up after yourself and take all of your “pool stuff” with you when you leave. There is no storage area for personal items. The Lost and Found Bucket is located in the Women’s Bathroom.
- Absolutely no glass containers anywhere in the pool area.
- Bicycles, skateboards and inline skates are not allowed in the pool area.
- Keep off the rope. Rope and buoys are expensive to replace. Rope anchors are easily pulled out and very difficult to reattach.
- Night swimming is prohibited and entering after dark is trespassing and will be dealt with accordingly. Pool hours are from 9 AM - 8 PM when daylight allows. The pool manager may close the pool earlier for required maintenance.
- Parties should be scheduled in advance to avoid overcrowding. Contact the Pool Manager to book a time.
- The pool cannot be exclusively reserved for parties. Party planner is responsible for cleaning after the party, including taking trash to dumpster and checking restrooms are in order. If your party includes a large group of children, please prepare plenty of adult supervision.
- Park only in the parking lot.
- Please clean up after yourself. There are brooms and supplies in the men’s bathroom for picking up or wiping any spills on tables or concrete.
- There is NO SMOKING allowed in or around the pool including the patio areas.
- If you are a member and see any abuses taking place at the pool, please do not hesitate to speak up or to contact a board member immediately.
